### Pupil Premium Grant Spending Statement For 2015 -16

#### Principles in the use of the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) at MRA:

Our priority for this academic year is to continue to focus on 'closing the attainment gap' between groups of pupils. And to focus particularly on those pupils who are not on track to achieve a Good Level of Development at the end of the EYFS. This will support improved outcomes for the Year 1 phonics test for PPG pupils. Through targeted interventions we are working to eliminate barriers to learning and progress. For those children eligible for PPG who start school with low attainment on entry, our aim is to ensure that they make accelerated progress in order to reach age related expectations as they move through the school. We will also ensure that high attainers are suitably challenged so that they achieve their potential and beyond.

#### Objectives

- To ensure PPG children continue to be tracked effectively and interventions are organised to support learning quickly.
- To support early intervention.
- To use specific resources to support learning in school.eg: Read Write Ink, Maths Mastery.
- To raise standards by improving engagement in learning through curriculum enrichment and celebration events.

### Provision

#### Process for monitoring impact:

- Half termly pupil progress meetings.
- Staff appraisal process.
- Principal's termly report to Governors.
- Termly meetings with the Local Authority School Improvement Officer.
