In school Barriers to Future Attainment (for pupils eligible for PP)					
Non-disadvantaged pupils have higher starting points in the Baseline Reception Assessments; the gap is wide on entry and whilst PP Pupils at MRA achieve as well as or better than pupils nationally, there is still a noticeable in school gap.					
Non-disadvantaged pupils at MRA often have highly aspirational parents who are motivated to support their children's learning. For a number of reasons our PP pupils may not have access to the same levels of support outside school.					
Many of our disadvantaged pupils come from low-income families who are not able to provide the access to opportunities our non-disadvantaged pupils are accessing outside our academy.
